General Hospital Questions

- 1. What dining options are available for myself and my spouse? Any 24 hour food options?
- 2. Does the hospital have wi-fi?
- 3. What sleeping options are available to my spouse?
- 4. Are the rooms and bathrooms private or shared?
- 5. Will I be in the same room for my entire hospital stay or do you have different rooms for labor, delivery, and postpartum?
- 6. Do you allow outside food to be brought in?
- 7. Do you have a professional photographer to take photos? (Some hospitals partner with local photographers and offer this service).
- 8. How many labor and delivery rooms do you have?
- 9. What happens if all of the rooms are full when I arrive?
- 10. Is this a teaching hospital? If so, can I request not to have a student in the room?
- 11. Can I play my own music in the room?
- 12. What types of security precautions are in place?
- 13. Can we decorate the door of our room?
- 14. What items do I need to bring, and what is supplied by the hospital?
- 15. Am I required to wear a hospital gown for my entire stay, or can I wear my own nightgown?
- 16. Can I preregister to save time during check-in?

Hospital Arrival

- 1. Where should I park?
- 2. What is the easiest way to get to the maternity wing?
- 3. What entrances are open if I arrive in the middle of the night?
- 4. What paperwork do I need to bring with me?
- 5. Do I need to call the hospital when I'm in labor and on my way?
- 6. What is the arrival process like if I have a scheduled induction?

Labor & Delivery

- 1. Will I be able to eat and drink while in labor? If so, what?
- 2. What pain management options do you offer?
- 3. Is an anesthesiologist always available?
- 4. For what reasons would I not be able to get an epidural?
- 5. What happens if I try to have a natural birth, but then decide that I need pain management medication?
- 6. Is there a limit on the number of people that are allowed in the room with me for labor and delivery?
- 7. Can I walk around while I am in labor, or do I have to stay in bed?
- 8. Will my husband be able to cut the cord?
- 9. Do you allow photos/videos to be taken during labor and delivery?
- 10. What is the process like if i need an emergency C-section? Who is allowed in the room?

Postpartum

- 1. How long are baby and I required to stay in the hospital after giving birth?
- 2. Will our baby be in our room for the duration of our stay?
- 3. Under what circumstances would our baby go to the nursery?
- 4. Will our baby be examined in the room with us?
- 5. Will we have skin-to-skin contact immediately following delivery?
- 6. Can I start the breastfeeding process immediately after delivery?
- 7. Is there a lactation specialist available to help with the nursing process?
- 8. Will my baby be given a pacifier?
- 9. Are meals provided for me after I give birth? What about my spouse?
- 10. Will my baby be given formula while in the nursery?

Guests

- 1. How many guests are allowed in the room at one time postpartum?
- 2. Where is the best place for guests to park?
- 3. Do guests need to go through any special security measures when they visit?
- 4. Are children allowed to visit during labor, delivery, and postpartum?
